



Canyon Lakes Property Owners Association Annual Board Meeting
February 12, 2019

The annual meeting was held at 7:00 pm in the Canyon Lakes Golf Course Champions Meeting room. Approximately 30 people were in attendance as well as various fire personnel to discuss the Bofer Canyon fire; August 11, 2018. The presentation lasted about one and a half hours.

A time line of the Bofer Canyon fire was discussed, how to sign up for Code Red alerts, what type of fire-resistant vegetation to plant and what the KFD is doing with the Community to improve fire safety within Communities. A few questions were asked by CLPOA residents. Jerry thanked all the fire personnel for coming and sharing such valuable information.

A power point presentation was given by Todd informing the property owners of the 2018/2019 financials, the CLPOA committees, 2018 strategic plans and 2019 strategic plans and the Long-Range Planning goals for the Community.
